### ROLE PURPOSE

To provide essential survey support to Northern Ashanti Mines Limited Company (NAMLC) by leading the Survey Team in the delivery of accurate, timely, and high-quality surveying services that underpin safe, efficient, and cost-effective mining operations.

The position is responsible for safeguarding the integrity and reliability of all survey data used for production planning, mine design compliance, operational reporting, and resource evaluation.

The successful candidate will work in close collaboration with the Mining, Geology, and Exploration teams to ensure best-in-class surveying standards are consistently achieved across all areas of the operation, thereby supporting informed decision-making and operational excellence.

### KEY ACCOUNTABILITIES

- Coordinate timely and accurate survey pickup of mine infrastructure, open pits, waste dumps, and stockpiles to support monthly volumetric reporting and reconciliation processes.
- Collaborate with the Geology, Exploration, and Mining teams to execute survey activities that support resource evaluation, mine planning, and operational decision-making.
- Conduct stakeout and set-out surveys for pit designs, haul roads, and other infrastructure to ensure compliance with approved engineering and mine design specifications.
- Perform routine topographic and infrastructure surveys to maintain accurate and up-to-date records of the mining environment.
- Undertake periodic pit pickups and as-built surveys to support mine planning, reconciliation, and long-term operational forecasting.
- Ensure drill and blast patterns are accurately marked and aligned with approved blast designs to achieve optimal drilling accuracy, fragmentation, and production outcomes.
- Maintain survey control networks and ensure the accuracy, reliability, and integrity of all survey data and deliverables.
- Ensure survey equipment is properly maintained, calibrated, and operated in accordance with manufacturer specifications and company standards.
- Process and analyze drone-captured imagery and spatial data using appropriate photogrammetry and GIS software to generate accurate orthophotos, digital terrain models (DTMs), and survey outputs.
- Train, coach, and mentor survey personnel to enhance technical competency, including the safe and effective use of drone/UAV technology, improve performance, and foster a culture of continuous improvement and safety.
- Prepare and submit accurate survey reports and data outputs within agreed timelines.
- Carry out any other duties reasonably assigned by the supervisor in support of operational objectives.

- Bachelor's Degree in Geomatic Engineering, Geodetic Engineering, Mine Surveying, or a related discipline from a recognised institution.
- A minimum of three (3) years' post-qualification experience in an operational mining environment.
- Proven proficiency in mining and survey software, including Surpac, Deswik CAD, and other relevant industry applications.

- Strong analytical and computer skills, with the ability to manage, interpret, and present survey data effectively.
- Demonstrated ability to read, interpret, and apply mine plans, technical drawings, and blast design documentation.
- Sound knowledge and practical experience in the setup, calibration, and operation of survey equipment, including Total Stations, GPS/GNSS systems, drones, and related technologies.
- Strong oral and written communication skills, with the ability to prepare clear and concise technical reports.
- Possession of a valid Ghanaian Driver's Licence with a minimum of five (5) years of active driving experience and the ability to safely operate vehicles in challenging mining environments.
